Subject: Authentication/Verification of Aadhaar.


This is in reference to communication received from O/o Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Gol vide letter numbering F.No. 10(22)/2017-EG-II(Vol-I)/E2404389 dated 03.07.2023 regarding subject cited above. (copy enclosed)

2 With Aadhaar becoming integral to delivery to residents of subsidies, benefits, services and where authorized by Aadhaar Act 2016, used for the purpose of good governance, social welfare benefits, innovation and spread of knowledge, it has become increasingly necessary that Aadhaar-using entities ensure the authenticity of Aadhaar being used by them, and not rely simply on Aadhaar cards or secondary sources purporting to represent Aadhaar data.

3 In this regard, vide above stated letter, MeitY, Gol has asserted that the authenticity of Aadhaar may be established either by online authentication of the identity of the Aadhaar number holder or doing offline verification of the digital signature of UIDAI on the QR code, e-Aadhaar or Aadhaar Paperless Offline e-KYC (XML). The procedures for Online authentication as well Offline Verification are defined under the Aadhaar (Authentication and offline Verification) Regulations, 2021. Also, regulation 16C of the said regulations provides that no Offline Verification Seeking Entity shall accept Aadhaar number in physical or electronic form (without authentication) as a proof of identity without first verifying UIDAI's digital signature.

4 A copy of the said letter is enclosed herewith with a request that in compliance to the guidelines issued by MeitY, Gol, suitable directions may be issued to all Aadhaar-using entities under your Department to not accept Aadhaar number in physical or electronic form (without authentication) as a proof of identity without first verifying UIDAI's digital signature and to carry out online authentication where the Aadhaar-using entity is a Requesting Entity appointed by UIDAI.

Subject: Authentication/verification of Aadhaar

Madam/sir,

Aadhaar is being used by State Governments for the purpose of establishing identity of individuals as a condition for receipt of subsidy, benefit or services for which expenditure is incurred from the Consolidated Fund of India or the State concerned. Further, entities authorised under section 4(4)(b)(ii) of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 for the purpose of good governance, social welfare benefits, innovation and spread of knowledge also use Aadhaar.

2. With Aadhaar becoming integral to delivery to residents of subsidies, benefits, services and, where authorised, for the aforesaid purposes, it has become increasingly necessary that Aadhaar-using entities ensure the authenticity of Aadhaar being used by them, and not rely simply on Aadhaar cards or other secondary sources purporting to represent Aadhaar data.

3. The authenticity of Aadhaar may be established either by online authentication of the identity of the Aadhaar number holder or doing offline verification of the digital signature of UIDAI on the QR code, e-Aadhaar or Aadhaar Paperless Offline e-KYC (XML).

4. Under the Aadhaar (Authentication and Offline Verification) Regulations, 2021, online authentication is available to Requesting Entities appointed by UIDAI. Such authentication may be done through UIDAI's eKYC or Yes/No authentication services, using the fingerprint, iris or face biometrics of the Aadhaar number holder.

5. Offline Verification Seeking Entities may make use of any of the offline verification procedures provided for in the regulations to verify UIDAI's digital signature against: ➔

- (a) the secure QR code, which is printed on the Aadhaar Letter issued to residents upon enrolment or the Aadhaar PVC card and may also be scanned by "Aadhaar QR Scanner" application available on Google Play Store and iOS Appstore;
- (b) eAadhaar (password-protected electronic copy of Aadhaar), which is downloadable from the UIDAI website or accessible using the mAadhaar app; and
- (c) Aadhaar Paperless Offline e-KYC (XML) (a secure, sharable document), which is downloadable from the UIDAI website or accessible using the mAadhaar app.

6. In this regard, it is also pertinent that regulation 16C of the said regulations provides that no Offline Verification Seeking Entity shall accept Aadhaar number in physical or electronic form (without authentication) as a proof of identity without first verifying UIDAI's digital signature.

7. For more details, the Headquarters or Regional Offices of UIDAI may be contacted.

8. Against this background, it is advised that suitable directions may be issued to all Aadhaar-using entities under the Government / Administration of the State / Union Territory to not accept Aadhaar number in physical or electronic form (without authentication) as a proof of identity without first verifying UIDAI's digital signature, and to carry out online authentication where the Aadhaar-using entity is a Requesting Entity appointed by UIDAI.
