

3.0 FURTHER THAT, attention is drawn to the relevant sections of Law regarding Election Duty.

Asper the Representation of People Act, 1951

134. Breaches of official duty in connection with election—

(1) If any person to whom this section applies is without reasonable cause guilty of any act or omission in breach of his official duty, he shall be punishable with fine whichmay extend to five hundred rupees.(1A) An offence punishable under sub-section (1) shall be <u>cognizable</u>.

*meansan offence for which a police officer may arrest without warrant.

4.0 Officers/ Employees deputed shall be personally liable for compliance. Failure to report to duty or refusal theretoshall attract <u>immediate legal action</u> as per the provisions of the Acts/ Sections mentioned above and other relevant provisions of the Law.
