As you are aware that reducing dropout of school children is one of the focus areas of Samagra Shiksha Scheme and National Education Policy, 2020. This issue is very prominently deliberated upon and discussed during the Project Approval Board (PAB) meetings while considering the Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B) of the State.

CBSI has conducted a survey (copy enclosed) on the status of study of JWS students after class 8<sup>th</sup>, wherein, it is observed that the dropout rate of students transitioning from class 8<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> is quite high in some States/UTs. It is high time to support them and bring them back in to education system. All necessary measures should be taken to ensure that the dropout rate of students is reduced to a minimum so that all the school going children are able to complete their education for their better future.

I, hereby, request you to direct the concerned Authorities to take the necessary measures to reduce the dropout rate in your State/UT.
