All DEOs may ensure that the terms and conditions mentioned in the NOC are strictly adhered to while organizing the campaign.

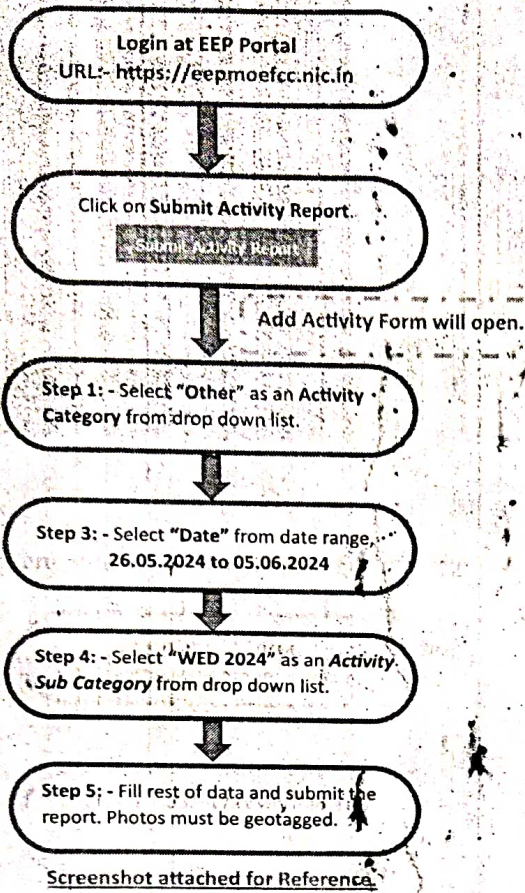


Subject: Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change Proposal - Prior concurrence regarding functions to be held on the occasion of World Environment Day on 05/06/2024 during the period of Model Code of Conduct - reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change letter No. 2111/1/2024GC, dated April 16, 2024, received from Joint Secretary, on the subject cited, and to state that the Commission has no objection, from MCC angle, to the proposal made therein subject to the condition that in respect of events/activities during the period of Model Code of Conduct, the following must be strictly adhered to:

1. Photos of any Minister/Political functionaries should not be displayed in the events in the Constituencies/districts where MCC is in force.
2. No political functionary should be invited during the event in the Constituencies/districts where MCC is in force.
3. The invitees participating in all the events must observe all conditions of MCC.
4. If any advt. is to be issued in this regard, it shall not have the photographs of any Minister/political functionaries in the newspapers having edition or circulation in the Constituencies/districts where MCC is in force.
