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

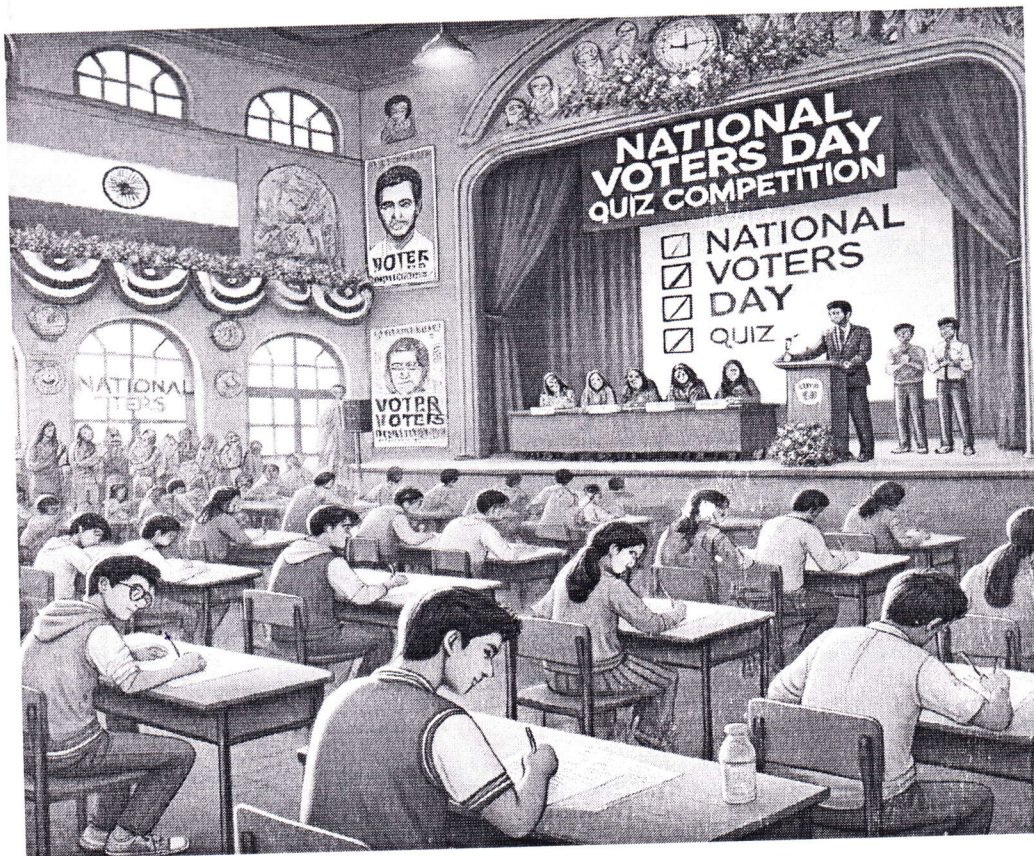

## Event Details:

### 1. Schedule:

- **Date:** 18th January 2025 to 25th January 2025
- **Event:** Quiz Competition for Class 9 - 11 students
- **Rounds:**
  - **Preliminary Round:** Conducted at individual schools between 18th to 24th January 2025.
  - **Final Round:** Held on 24th January 2025 at [Venue to be decided], Bathinda.
- **Award Ceremony:** Top 3 participants of each school will be awarded on 25th of Jan (on the National Voters Day) and the overall top 3 students will be awarded by Honorable DC Sir on Republic Day, 26th January 2025.

### 2. Eligibility:

- Only students of **Class 9 to 11** are eligible to participate.

### 3. Participation Details:

- Schools are requested to nominate interested students only (minimum 60 students from each school).
- Each school should submit participant details in the attached Google Sheet.
- **Information Required:**

- **Submission Deadline:** 12th January 2025

### 4. Selection Criteria:

- **Preliminary Round:** Top 3 students from each school will be selected.
- **Final Round:** Top 3 participants from the final round will be declared winners.

## 5. Rewards:

- **Final Round Winners:**
  - **1st Place:** Award and Certificate
  - **2nd Place:** Award and Certificate
  - **3rd Place:** Award and Certificate
- **Participation Certificates:** The top 10 participants (scorer) from each school will receive certificates.

## Syllabus for Quiz:

The quiz will cover the following topics:

1. **Indian Constitution:** Key articles and amendments related to elections, Fundamental Rights, Fundamental Duties, DPSP (Directive Principles of State Policy), Citizenship, and Preamble.
2. **Election Process:** Roles of Election Commission, voter registration, EVMs, and VVPAT.
3. **Famous Personalities:** Influential figures in Indian politics and democracy.
4. **History of Elections in India:** Milestones and notable moments.
5. **Current Affairs:** Topics related to governance and elections in India.
6. **Modern History:** From 1915 to 1947.

  - a. Fill out the attached Google Sheet with details of the interested students.
  - b. Ensure all information is accurate and submitted by the deadline.
2. **Preliminary Round and Final Round Details:**
  - a. The preliminary round and the final round will be conducted by the District Administration.
  - b. Schools should ensure the attendance of their selected participants at the designated venue.
