The Department of Food & Public Distribution has concurred the allocation of  
1017149.99 MTs of food grains, comprising 161667.41 MTs of wheat and 855482.58  
MTs of fortified rice vide O.M. No. 4-2/2024-BP-II dated 27.09.2024 (copy enclosed) to  
States & UTs at National Food Security Act (NFSA) prices i.e. Rs.2.00 per kg of wheat and  
Rs.3.00 per kg of rice under the PM POSHAN Scheme for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter (October to  
December, 2024) and 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter (January to March, 2025) of financial year 2024-25.  
Accordingly, the food grains allocation for States & UTs for Primary, Upper Primary classes  
and Bal Vatika for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarters of 2024-25 is enclosed at Annexure-I, Annexure-  
II, Annexure-III respectively. Allocation of food grains for drought affected areas, as  
approved by PAB for the Financial Year 2024-25 is also enclosed at Annexure-IV. The  
allocation of Coarse Grains for FY 2024-25 will be done after its availability is  
confirmed by the Dept. of Food & Public Distribution.

- For the 1st and 2nd quarter of FY 2024-25, foodgrains were allocated on the basis of  
the PAB approvals for FY 2023-24. However, during the PAB for FY 2024-25, some of the  
States/UTs have not given proposals for Bal Vatikas and NCLP. Accordingly, in case of such  
States/UTs the foodgrains allocated for Bal Vatika and NCLP for 1st and 2nd quarter have  
been adjusted with allocations for 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> quarters of FY 2024-25 for Primary and Upper  
Primary classes.
- The validity period for lifting of food grains will be as per the extant guidelines.  
The States & UTs are requested to further allocate the food grains to the districts as per their  
requirement on the basis of approved number of children and working days under intimation  
to this Department as well as to the Food Corporation of India (FCI) for supply of food  
grains.
- After receiving food grains allocation from the States & UTs, the District Administration  
will send a schedule (periodicity and date/week) of lifting of food grains to the local FCI  
Depot depending upon its requirement, transportation convenience and storage capacity.
- District Administration may lift allocated food grains from the FCI godowns on  
monthly, bi-monthly or quarterly basis as indicated in its schedule, in accordance with the

No. 5-1/2023-Desk (PMP) dated 17.09.2024 and subsequent email dated 23.09.2024 on the above mentioned subject and to convey the approval of this Department for allocation of 1017149.99 MTs (1,61,667.41 MTs Wheat + 8,55,482.58 MTs Rice) of food grains for the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of FY 2024-25 under PM POSHAN Scheme to Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education at NFSA rate i.e. Rs. 2 per kg for wheat and Rs. 3 per kg for rice.

2. The validity period for lifting of foodgrains will be as per extant guidelines.
3. The Department of School Education & Literacy may communicate State/UT-wise allocation of the allocated quantity of foodgrains to FCI and States/UTs well in time and ensure its lifting within the stipulated validity period by States/UTs.
4. Food Corporation of India (FCI) would issue fortified rice and wheat as per State/UT-wise allocation for the year 2023-24 with monthly breakup to be made by the Department of School Education and Literacy.
5. The allocation of Coarse Grains will be done after its availability under PM POSHAN Scheme is confirmed by FCI/ Policy-III Section.
6. The Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education may ensure that FCI gets full payment in respect of foodgrains released by it to States/UTs under the Scheme & utilization certificates are furnished by the State/UT Governments to it in time. They are also requested to make payment of outstanding amounts to FCI without any delays as FCI bears huge amount of interest on unpaid outstanding amount.


6. Payment of the cost of food grains will be made by the District authorities within 20 days of the receipt of bills from FCI as per the guidelines issued by this Department vide letter No. 1-3/2022- Desk(PM POSHAN) dated 21.12.2022. The guidelines for decentralization of payment of cost of food grains to FCI at district level under PM POSHAN Scheme may also be downloaded from the website of this Department. These instructions may be followed strictly by all the States & UTs.

7. Procedure laid down in para 5.5 of the above mentioned guidelines dated 21.12.2022 on decentralization of payment of cost of food grains shall be followed meticulously to ensure that the best quality food grains, which in any case will not be inferior to Fair Average Quality (FAQ), is lifted from the FCI godown. The process followed at the time of receipt of food grains from FCI depots should be repeated at each level till the food grains reach the end user to ensure that only good quality food grains are delivered for consumption by children. Records/samples to ensure quality should be maintained at all levels.

8. As per para 5.3 of PM POSHAN Guidelines, a monthly report on off take, payment and quantity of food grains sent to schools/cooking agency may be furnished in the prescribed format latest by 15<sup>th</sup> of the following month on regular basis.


