As you are aware, Punjab State Council for Science & Technology is the State Nodal Agency for implementing Environment Education Programme (EEP) in Punjab. Under EEP, a number of activities are conducted involving the school eco-clubs in all districts of Punjab. We are proud to bring out that many eco-club schools have performed exceptionally well at the State as well as National Level bringing several awards and recognitions to the State for activities such as Green Schools Programme, Eco Creativity & Innovation Hackathon and WIPRO Earthian Programme. To honour the best performing schools, teachers & District EEP Coordinators and implement the Green Schools Programme 2025-26 at the district level, the Council is pleased to sanction an amount of Rs.1,60,000/- to your district as per following details :

For initiating the Green Schools Program in 2025-26, a training program of District Coordinators (2 from each district) is expected to be held in July, 2025 at Anil Agarwal Environment Training Institute (AAETI), Alwar which will be conducted by Centre for Science &

Environment (CSE). After the training the trained Coordinators will conduct training programs for all eco-clubs in their respective districts. After the training, the eco-clubs will register themselves on the national portal of MoEFCC at <http://eepmoefcc.nic.in/> and take up activities such as environment audits, consumption of natural resources within school campuses, energy auditing and deploying pragmatic solutions to reduce wastage of precious resources and submit their activity reports to MoEF&CC and CSE which will adjudge the schools through a number of parameters. Best schools will also be awarded by CSE in a national level event.

The District Coordinators are required to strictly adhere to the following guidelines while conducting the GSP:

- 1.) As per the guidelines of the program, it is mandatory to include the logos of Mission LiFE, MoEF&CC & PSCST and also mention that the program is being organized under the Environment Education Program (EEP). Logos should be used in all banners, advertisements, social media posts and certificates. The matter for banner along with the logos is attached as Annexure-III & IV.
- 2.) The press releases, social media posts should duly acknowledge Punjab State Council for Science & Technology as the State Nodal Agency and Ministry of Environment & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) as the catalysing and supporting agency for the Environment Education Programme.
- 3.) The format for submission of Utilization Certificate and Project Completion Report is attached as Annexure-V.

Environment Education Programme Logo Design Competition

The Environment Education Programme (EEP) of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India aims to sensitize children and youth about environmental issues and to encourage them to adopt sustainable lifestyles. This programme supplements formal education through various pedagogical initiatives like workshops, exhibitions, nature camps, etc. Eco-clubs formed in educational institutions are the prime channel through which this programme imparts environmental education and this has a cascading effect when the messages are carried by children/ youth to their homes and society.

As compared to the earlier efforts of the Ministry, the programme strives to shift from symbolic activities to focused campaigns for fostering critical thinking and environmental responsibility. Emphasizing hands-on experiences, it seeks to bridge classroom knowledge with practical learning. The activities are aligned with Mission Lifestyle for Environment (LiFE) to promote living in harmony with nature.

Environment Education Division announces a competition to design a logo for 'Environment Education Programme (EEP)' which may be used on the website/ mobile app/ social media such as Twitter/ Facebook/ Instagram and on Magazines, Commercial Hoardings/ Standees/ Brochures/ Leaflets and Pamphlets/ Souvenirs and other Publicity and Marketing materials/ Posters/ Printed materials or anywhere else as the Environment Education Division choose. This document describes the official requirements and rules of the competition.

- Sustainable Lifestyle Practices / alternatives / development
- Growth and Environment Protection
- Adopt healthy lifestyle
- Conservation and preservation of energy / water
- Waste management / Reduce waste
- Conservation of nature and natural resources
- The concept of 5 R's: Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Repurpose, Recycle

Terms & Conditions

1. The last date for accepting entries is **05-03-2024 at 05:30 PM**.
2. Each entry should be accompanied by a brief written explanation of the Logo and how best it encapsulates its essence.
3. Eco clubs will be submitting all the entries for the Logo Design Competition to their respective Implementing Agencies (IAs). The IAs will select the three best entries and submit the same through email to EE Division, MoEF&CC. Entries submitted through any other medium/mode would not be considered for evaluation.
4. The contest is only open for the Ecoclubs. The entry could be an individual project or a team project.
5. Each participant/ team can submit **ONLY** one entry. The submission of entry is free.
6. Please note that the logo must be original and should not violate any provision of the Indian Copyright Act, 1957 or the Intellectual Property Rights of any third party. The logo should not have been previously published in any print and digital media and must not contain any provocative, objectionable or inappropriate content.
7. In case of any copy right issues, the respective Implementing Agencies will be responsible to settle any legal proceedings arising out of it at his/her end. Environment Education Division (EE Division) Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate change (MoEF&CC) will not be responsible.
8. Plagiarism of any nature is not allowed. Anyone found infringing on others' copyright would be disqualified from the contest.
9. All entries are governed by the provisions of Emblems and Names (Prevention of improper use) Act, 1950 and any violation of the said Act will result in disqualification.
10. The onus will be on the participant/applicant to prove that he/she is the only authorized representative to send the entry for the Award Scheme. In case of the selection of the Logo for an award, it will be given to the participant/applicant only. EE Division, MoEF&CC will, in no way, be responsible for any dispute, legal or otherwise, arising out of it.
11. The responsibility to comply with the Submission of entries, Competition Technical Criteria and Selection Process fully lies with the participant(s)/Implementing agencies and EE Division, MoEF&CC shall not be answerable to any dispute raised by a third party.
12. EE Division, MoEF&CC takes no responsibility for corrupted or late entries.
13. The winner will be declared through email or by way of announcing his / her name on EEP Portal.
14. The winning design of the logo would be the intellectual property of EE Division, MoEF&CC and the winner cannot exercise any right over it, after acceptance of the prize. EE Division, MoEF&CC will have unfettered right to modify the Prize winning

logo / entry or add/delete any info/design feature in any form to it. The winner will not exercise any right over his/her Logo and shall not use it in any way.

15. The winning logo is meant to be used by EE Division, MoEF&CC for promotional and display purposes, Information, Education and Communication materials and also for any other use as may be deemed appropriate by the EE Division, MoEF&CC.

16. There will be no notification to participants of rejected entries.

17. EE Division, MoEF&CC reserves the right to cancel or amend all or any part of the Contest and/ or the Terms & Conditions/ Technical Parameters/ Evaluation Criteria. It would be the responsibility of the participants to keep themselves informed about any changes in the Terms & Conditions/ Technical Parameters /Evaluation Criteria stated for this Contest.

Technical Criteria

1. Logo should be submitted in JPEG, PNG or PDF format only.
2. Logo should be designed in colour.
3. File should be high resolution – at least 300 pixels per inch at 100% size.
4. File should look clean (not pixilated or bit-mapped) when viewed on screen at 100%

Selection Process

1. All entries submitted received by the stipulated date and found in order, shall be evaluated by a Selection Committee. The Committee will shortlist the entries and will decide the winner if an entry is found suitable.
2. Entries would be judged on the basis of elements of creativity, originality, composition, technical excellence, simplicity, artistic merit and visual impact and how well they communicate the theme of Environment Education Programme.
3. The decision of the Selection Committee would be final and binding on all the contestants and no clarifications would be issued to any participants or on any decision of the Selection Committee.
4. There will be only one winner of competition.
5. Winner shall be required to provide the original source file of the designed logo.
6. The winning entry will be considered for Award and a certificate from Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate change.
7. Any legal proceedings arising out of the competition/ its entries/ winners shall be subject to local jurisdiction of NCT of Delhi only. Expenses incurred for this purpose will be borne by the parties themselves.
8. EE Division, MoEF&CC, if it so decides, reserves the right not to proceed with the competition at any stage.
