Subject: Jal Sanchay Jan Bhagidari Scheme – regarding.

1.0 Please refer to the discussions held in the meeting taken by the Chief Secretary, Punjab on 01.04.2025.

2.0 The Ministry of Jal Shakti, Government of India, has launched Jal Sanchay Jan Bhagidari Scheme under which various activities relating to the rain water harvesting/recharge structures, check dams, cleaning of ponds, connecting of ponds with canals are generally being taken. The Ministry has decided that all such water recharging structures need to be Geo-tagging on a portal of the Ministry. Accordingly, it has been decided that all such water bodies need to be geo-tagged. For this purpose SDO, Canal and Ground Water at the district level has already been provided ID. The SDOs may be asked to create further IDs with various departments.

3.0 During the meeting held on 01.04.2025 it was decided that the following departments need to fill up the data on the portal:

- (i) Department of Water Resources
- (ii) Department of Rural Development & Panchayat
- (iii) Department of Soil & Water Conservation
- (iv) Department of Housing & Urban Development
- (v) Department of Local Government
- (vi) Department of Industries & Commerce
- (vii) Department of School Education

4.0 You are requested to kindly coordinate with all the departments and get the needful done. It is further submitted that the progress is being monitored at the level of the CS on regular basis. Next review meeting shall be held on 09.04.2025 at 01:00 PM through VC.
