SCHEME OF ICCW BRAVERY AWARDS FOR CHILDREN & YOUTH (2026)

INTRODUCTION: The Scheme of Awards to Children for bravery was started 68 years ago in the year 1957. It was in this year that two children a boy and a girl were first rewarded for their exemplary presence of mind and courage. Since then, ICCW confers these Awards to children, every year.

In 2023, the ICCW National Bravery Awards were renamed as "ICCW Bravery Awards for Children & Youth".

OBJECTIVES: The main objective of the scheme is to give due recognition to the children and youth who perform acts of bravery with a view to inspire other children to follow their example. The deed should be "an act of spontaneous selfless service in the face of risk to life or threat of physical injury and or an act of courage and daring against a social evil/crime".

PROCESS OF INVITING APPLICATIONS: Wide publicity is given for the Programme. Nominations are invited from all over India.

PROCESS OF APPLYING: Nominations are received in the prescribed application form which can be obtained from ICCW headquarters office or can be downloaded from ICCW's website. The application should be recommended by the listed Competent Authorities. The form is to be accompanied by a write-up of about 250 words giving the details of the deed performed by the applicant, proof of date of birth, Newspaper/Magazine clippings and/or the First Information Report (FIR) or Police Diary filed with the Police Station. The account of the incident as well as the supporting documents should preferably be endorsed by the listed Competent Authorities.

AGE-LIMIT: Awards will be given in two categories.

- The applicant should not be below 6 years and above 18 years of age on the date of the incident (Child Award).
- The applicant should not be below 18 years and above 24 years of age on the date of the incident (Youth Award).

RECOMMENDING/COMPETENT AUTHORITIES: The application must be recommended by the following:

1. Principal/Headmaster of the school/college in which the applicant is studying.
2. President or General Secretary or any other Office Bearer of the State/UT Council for Child Welfare/Institutional Members.
3. Any retired Government Officer.

DATE OF INCIDENT: Incidents which have occurred between July 1, 2025 and September 30, 2026 will be considered for the 2026 awards. The Selection Committee, may at its discretion, relax the date by a maximum period of six months prior to July 1, 2025 if it so deems fit. ICCW reserves the right to relax the date of the deed for a very deserving act for recognition.

DATE OF SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION: Last date of submission of application is October 05, 2026.

SELECTION PROCEDURE: The selection is made by a high powered Committee constituted by ICCW. Applications once rejected for whatever reason will not be entertained again. The Selection Committee may at its discretion consider relaxation of any of the conditions/rules if it so deems fit.

Submission of Application does not guarantee Selection.
The decision of the Selection Committee shall be final.

- > A medal (Gold, Silver)
- > A certificate
- > Cash award.

The Awardees also receive various gifts from philanthropic organizations.
The Award will be presented at New Delhi by an eminent and distinguished personality.
